Our basic management policies

We manage our center to promote secure, reliable, and complete medical checkups for primary care, proposing “Starting Health Promotion with a Medical Checkup” according to the following basic policies:

1. We provide secure, comfortable medical checkups using appropriate methods for preventive medicine while respecting the human rights of customers and having the same perspective as our customers.
2. Our medical checkups include basic test items as well as tests providing new evidence to prevent lifestyle-related diseases. We will provide customers with health guidance to prevent physical and mental presymptomatic conditions based on the medical checkup results.
3. We are thorough and careful about the management of our customers’ information in compliance with social rules and laws and regulations.
4. We maintain a safe, comfortable working environment for our staff on a continuous basis while respecting their individual human rights and characters.

Meiji Yasuda Shinjuku Medical Center is a secure, reliable institution specialized in providing complete medical checkups with over 40 years of experience.

Our reliability, history, and experience

- Meiji Yasuda Shinjuku Medical Center is one of the best traditional institutions in Tokyo, which was established in 1975 by the Meiji Yasuda Health Development Foundation built in 1962. Since the establishment of the center, a total of over 650,000 individuals underwent medical checkups.
- Our center is a member of more than 500 health insurance associations and has been registered as a specific health checkup institution. In addition, our center is available for individuals who have a health insurance card from the Japan Health Insurance Association.

Location very close to the South Exit of Shinjuku Station

- Since our center is close to Shinjuku Station and adjacent to the O-1 Exit of the underground called One Day Street, you can comfortably visit our center irrespective of the weather.

Can receive a medical checkup on a gender basis every day on weekdays.

- In accordance with moving to the current location, a larger space is available for medical checkups from Monday to Friday irrespective of gender.
- Medical checkup areas for men and women are separated for to ensure more comfortable examinations.
*Medical checkups are also available on Saturdays on an irregular basis.

Rapid medical checkups

- Our latest medical checkup management system reduces the waiting time for the examination as much as possible.
- Examinations (complete medical checkups) that are completed within two to three hours in the morning or afternoon make it possible for our customers to use their time more efficiently.

A full range follow-up system

- We have a variety of follow-up systems for customers who need further examinations or retesting.
- A public health nurse and a national registered dietitian will support your health promotion after the checkup. If you have any questions about the checkup results, our nurse or public health nurse will provide you with an explanation via telephone counseling after the checkup.

Explanation of the results	Medical explanation and counseling with a physician*
Telephone counseling	Providing an explanation of the test items and counseling before and after the medical checkup via telephone
Referral to a medical institution	Providing advice about preferable medical institutions to undergo further examinations or retesting
Health counseling	Consultation for improving lifestyles by an expert*

Enforcement of medical coordination mainly with university hospitals

- When you receive instructions for a medical consultation but you are not sure where to go specifically, we will refer you to one of our collaborative medical institutions, including university hospitals (e.g., Jikei University Hospitals [the main institution in Shinbashi, Minato City, Tokyo; Katsushika Medical Center in Katsushika City, Tokyo; Daisan Hospital in Komae City, Tokyo; and Kashiwa Hospital in Kashiwa City, Chiba]).

Upper gastrointestinal endoscopy for more accurate and closer follow-up

- We increased the number of examination rooms to eight in response to the increasing number of customers who desire an endoscopy examination.
- The nasal or oral endoscopy procedure is basically conducted without sedation. However, persons who are concerned about the examination can select a procedure with sedation (only the oral endoscopy procedure is available in such a case) to reduce any potential pain.

*Advanced reservations and an additional fee are required for endoscopy with sedation.

Female laboratory technicians conduct ultrasonography and mammography exams

- Highly rated female laboratory and radiology technicians conduct the examinations in a careful manner.

Respect for diversity without borders for people with disabilities, LGBTQ community, and any other individuals

- Our center is making efforts to allow everyone access to medical checkups.

Persons with hearing impairments	Although we have no specialized sign language interpreter, we will communicate through written messages. In addition, we have a brochure that explains the examinations for easy understanding.
Persons with vision problems	Our qualified staff can serve as a personal support worker to assist you as needed.
Persons in wheelchairs	We have dressing rooms that are wheelchair accessible and barrier-free toilets, including those for ostomates and children.
LGBTQ persons	We have a special room. Please consult us about the preferable times for the medical checkup as well.
Persons from overseas	Our brochures are also available in English for easier understanding of the examinations. In addition, we can prepare questionnaires and examination result report in English. We lend translation machines as well.

Introduction of the charge-free application CARADA Support for Medical Checkups

- We introduced the charge-free application CARADA Support for Medical Checkups by which you can access your examination results as part of the services for our customers.
- The application is helpful in taking action for presymptomatic conditions by reviewing medical checkup results for the past five years* and graphs of changes in the test values over time.
- Even if you develop an acute condition, you can access your medical checkup results anytime and anywhere by a smartphone.

Floor Map

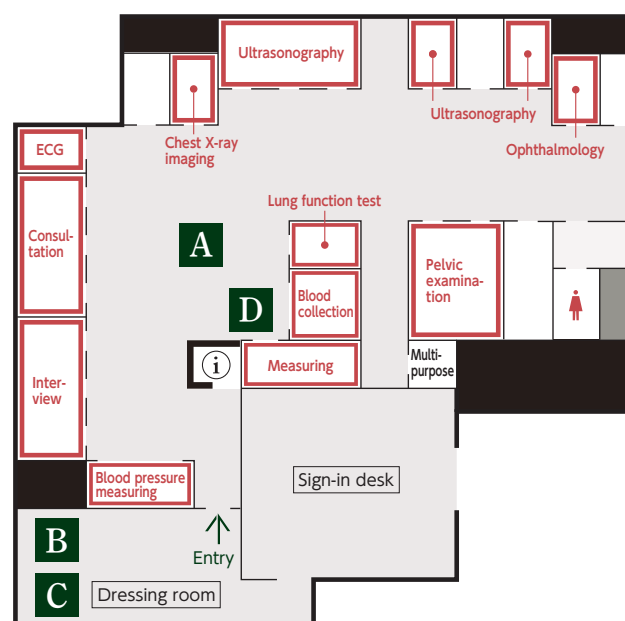
We offer the latest testing devices and one of the region's largest spaces for medical checkups by gender.

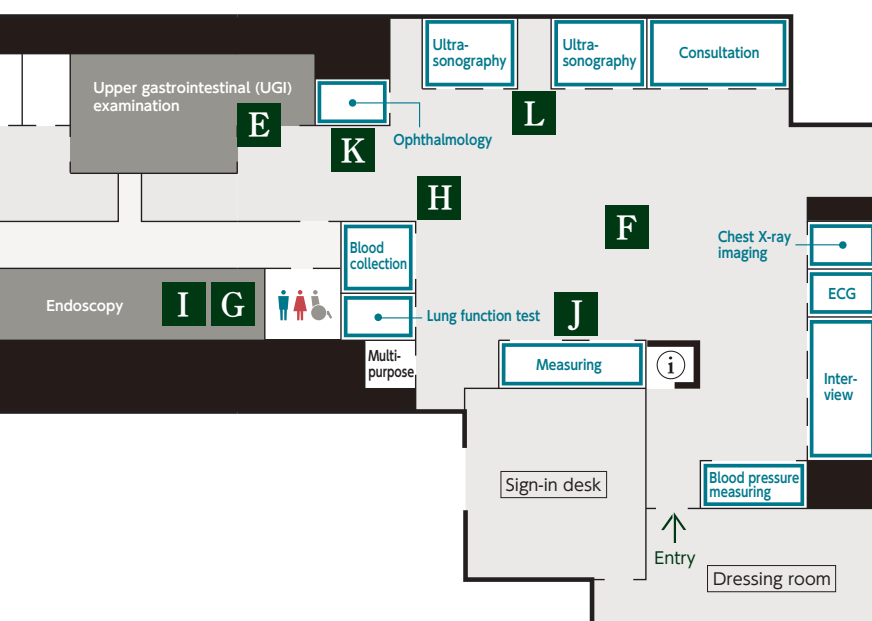

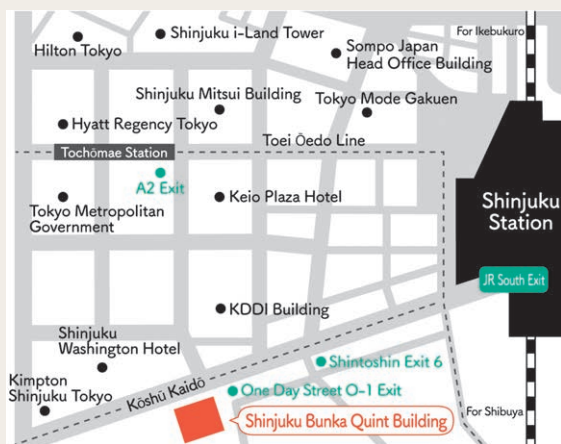
